

Project meeting with a Sustainable and Digital Municipalities Conference in Rivas Vaciamadrid, Spain

At the end of May, 12 project partners and a representative of CINEA, an agency of the European Commission, met in Rivas to discuss the progress work of the POWER-E-COM project. The meeting was organised in conjunction with a conference on Digital Municipalities, which brought together Spanish energy experts and included a panel of speakers from the project.

Key takeaways from the conference:

- Energy communities are essential for achieving a sustainable energy future.
- There are many challenges and opportunities associated with establishing energy communities.
- Collaboration is key to success.





Effecting Change for Energy Communities event in Ireland!

A high-level meeting was held with the Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action in Government Buildings, Dublin in March 2024. Representatives from a number of communities including Claremorris Energy Cooperative, Sustainable Community Area Network Galway and POWER-E-COM project partner Community Power, met with Minister Eamon Ryan to discuss the challenges facing community energy in Ireland.



POWER-E-COM at the EUBCE - European Biomass Conference & Exhibition 2024!

In July Ingo Ball (WIP Renewable Energies) had the opportunity to present the project to industry and academic leaders at the EUBCE - European Biomass Conference & Exhibition 2024! He discussed about the concept of community-owned micro-grid heating systems. These concepts, known as 'village heating', are already flourishing in the Bavarian.





Oberland Region in Germany hosted an event on Energy Communities

In July, our German project partner Energiewende Oberland hosted a successful event, bringing together energy communities, citizens, businesses and municipalities to discuss the future of energy communities in the region. The event featured insightful presentations, that provided a comprehensive overview of the legal framework and potential of energy communities, shared valuable insights into energy community experiences in the heat sector, and best practices from Austria.

Key takeaways from the event:

The event highlighted the growing interest in energy communities and their potential to contribute to a more sustainable and decentralised energy system. Participants engaged in lively discussions on the opportunities and challenges associated with both electricity and heat energy communities in the Oberland region. The event served as a valuable platform for knowledge sharing and networking. The insights gained from these discussions will inform future activities and help to create more opportunities for community engagement.
